- **Dutch Square - Stadhuays 1641 - 1660/ Christ Church 1753 / Queen Victoria Fountain 1901.**
- **Chinatown - Jonker Street, Harmony Street, Millionaire Street**
- **Chinese Temple, Hindu Temple & Malay Mosque**
- **Ruins of St.Paul's Hill: A'Famosa / View of Straits of Malacca /**
- **Replica of Sultan's Palace/Independence Building/ Memorial Club House.**
